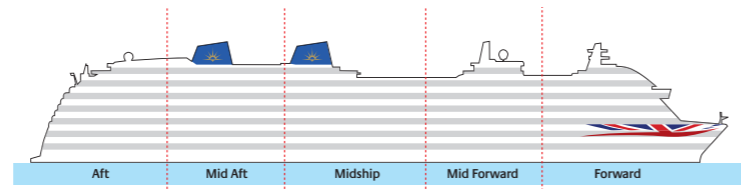

Cabin Notes

- * Cabin has one additional bed in the form of a single sofa bed
 - Cabin has one additional bed in the form of a pull-down bed
 - ** Cabin has two additional beds in the form of a double sofa bed
 - ◇ Cabin has two additional beds in the form of pull-down beds
 - ≈ Cabin has two additional beds, one in the form of a single sofa bed and one in the form of a pull-down bed
 - ◆ Cabin contains fixed twin beds and two additional beds in the form of pull-down beds. Applicable to all 4 bed Inside
 - # Steel fronted balcony
 - v Overlooked by balconies above
 - ∨ Balcony is partially shaded
 - ♻ All adapted cabins have a shower only
 - ⊕ Restricted access to balcony (when at sea)
- Note:** all pull-down beds in twin cabins are accessible via a ladder. When pull-down beds are in use, lower beds cannot be converted to a double. Balconies in the forward section of the ship can be overlooked by the bridge.
